Member Page

Member alerts can be also set as a pop up through toy library settings. If this setting is turned on, alerts will be displayed when the member's page is opened. There is a cool down period of 10 minutes so if the member's page has been visited in the past 10 minutes, the pop up will not appear again. However, the alerts are always visible in the Alerts box to the right of screen, and can be added/edited/deleted through this view.
